Reading Tests with Nonsense Words

The following four tests will assist you in selecting the correct book to begin a pupil on, and thereafter to help you decide when a student is of a standard to move on to the next book, from Books 1 to 5.

However, these tests are not to be used to determine the reading age of a student.

Below are the guidelines for testing and assessing your pupils:

- If they complete List 1 with two errors or less, they can begin at Book 2.
- 2. If they complete both List 1 & 2, with two errors or less in each, they can begin at Book 3.
- 3. If they complete List 1, 2 & 3 with two errors or less in each, they can begin at Book 4.
- 4. If they complete List 1, 2, 3 & 4 with two errors or less in each, they can begin at Book 5.
 - a. There is a caveat here: if you start them on Book 5, but they soon begin to struggle with it, it is recommended to desist immediately and start them on Book 4.
